Community Supported Agriculture, called CSA, is a program designed to connect the community with the farm. When you buy a membership 100% of the purchase price goes to support the local farm. You help the farm at the start of the season when costs are high and income is low. In return, you get local farm fresh produce weekly. At the start, selection and quantities are limited but they soon increase as the weather and growing season advances.

In a CSA program, individuals and families commit to support local farms. Members receive fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs and farm fresh products from farms within a fifty mile radius of their home. Picked ripe and made available within just a few days, this produce contains more flavor and higher nutritional value and requires minimal if any use of non-organic treatments. In return, farmers receive a commitment of a fair market price for their products and delivery. Each CSA operates in its own unique way, but the basic idea remains the same; consumers and farmers collaborating to ensure a safe and healthy food source for their local community.

Each week of the CSA season you'll find a selection of seasonal produce waiting for you at Country Corner. You will also receive and find recipes for preparing your seasonal produce through our farm community member network.
